A 30 min Audiovision Show presented by Nicole&Urs Denier with Spike



On our last trip through the Kalahari and Okavango Delta we could not find the rhino which would have made our „Big Five“ sighting complete. This was a good reason to return once more to southern Africa in order to compose a new story. Accompanied by the experienced safari guide Spike, the warthog, this 30-minute Audiovision Show will take you through locations in Zimbabwe, Botswana and South Africa.

Our companion Spike moderates and leads through the entire 4-week journey. Although he has to cope with the prevailing scorching heat, he takes his duty serious and does also not get distracted by the German translator.

Our search for the rhino begins with camping amidst the Gonarezhou National Park, surrounded by a scenic backdrop of the Chilojo rocks. Partly on foot, it comes to close encounters and beautiful shots of elephant families with young animals.

In Botswana, Spike guides us through the Mashatu Game Reserve. He presents the audience the agony of the Burchell's Coucals, a successful hunt of the world's fastest mammal, riddled with insights into the nursery, but also tells the very sad story of a young wildebeest and confronts the viewer with the merciless Nature. As a contrast, the spectator is enchanted by the colorful bird life and its fascinating sounds.

Spike further follows us from Botswana to South Africa to explore the wilderness partly by bike, surrounded by zebras, impalas and giraffes. This trip is topped with a rather rare and impressive sighting in the Sabi Game Reserve. However it is neither a chase nor a rhino sighting but more details are not revealed at this point.

Moreover, the clever Spike does also not disclose whether we were successful in our rhino tracking attempts until the end of the show.
